CORI RENEWAL FOR SHRINE VOLUNTEERS

SAFETY TRAINING FOR LITURGICAL MINISTERS

June 8 in Welcome Center Room A, 9-3:00PM

Every week we have 400 to 500 people attend Mass at the Shrine. Emergencies of all sorts can happen. People fall, faint, have a heart attack, or just become ill. Churches have recently become targets for violence as well. Our liturgical ministers (whether an usher or eucharistic minister) should all consider themselves as first responders. On June 8th, there will be training to respond to several emergencies we could face. Walpole Police Lieutenant Fred Leland, a former Marine, and FBI trained emergency responder, will spend the day and prepare us for several different emergencies.

At Mass, we celebrate the real presence of Christ in our lives. We must remember that the congregation is also the Body of Christ, and we need to care for them the same way we do for the Eucharistic species. *This training is critical, please make every attempt to attend. 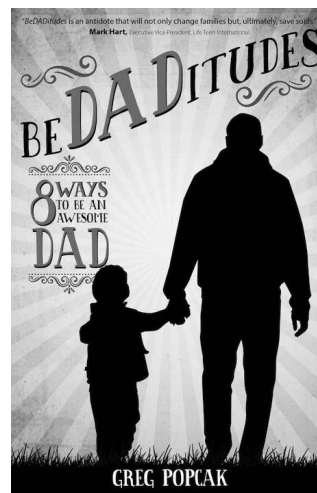
