

Office of the Bishop

Dear Father:

I hope that your Pentecost was Spirit-filled. It is indeed a time during which we need to expect and pray for a New Pentecost, which our Church so deeply needs in the midst of these challenging days. We, ourselves, must continue to beg the Holy Spirit to pour out those graces that were showered down upon our early Church and remind those around us to fervently pray for the same. Thank you for your continual witness to those graces by your ministry.

Even though our diocese is journeying toward a new day and a New Pentecost, we are tasked with handling problems that we inherited, and are called in these times to be part of the solution.

As was announced in February, our diocese - along with the Arch/Dioceses of Newark, Trenton, Camden and Paterson - established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest or a member of the clergy of the diocese. Anyone who is a victim of sexual abuse by a priest of the Diocese is encouraged to participate in the IVCP.

The program will be open to claims beginning June 15 and will conclude on December 31, 2019. All individual claims must be submitted during this period. More information about the IVCP and a detailed list of FAQ's can be found on our diocesan website: diometuchen.org/ivcp. I ask you to please promote this program in your parish via: bulletins, your parish website or social media pages, and in any other way you believe might help to get the word out. Following this letter, you will find a joint advertisement that was developed on behalf of the five arch/dioceses in New Jersey and can be used as a flyer, as well as a bulletin announcement that has already been made available to your parish bulletin editor.

The implementation of IVCP is an important step in aiding victims in seeking justice and healing and its success depends on our promoting it. Now is a decisive time in the history of our diocese and our Church to hear His call for renewal and to be awakened in faith for the sake of His mission.

Let us hear and heed His call for renewal, especially as we are in the midst of our Year of Spiritual Awakening in preparation for the consecration of our diocese to Jesus through Our Lady of Guadalupe, and ask God to bless our diocese with a new Pentecost and a renewed fervor for the Holy Spirit. Know of my continued love and prayers.
