From the desk of Fr. Ben...

17 April 2016



This 4th Sunday of Easter is called by the nickname "Good Shepherd Sunday" because the Gospel speaks of this theme in all three years of the Sunday lectionary cycle. One of the principal ways that Jesus shepherds and guides us is through the living Word of God, especially as the Scriptures are proclaimed in the liturgy. Every Sunday at Mass, we experience something that has been part of the Christian life from the very beginning: "Paul and

Barnabas continued on from Perga and reached Antioch in Pisidia. On the sabbath they entered the synagogue and took their seats. Many Jews and worshipers who were converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who spoke to them and urged them to remain faithful to the grace of God." What a beautiful goal for me as your pastor (shepherd), that in eve-

ry homily I would "speak to you and urge you to remain faithful to the grace of God," just like St. Paul!

Last weekend Anna Dijkstra was confirmed by Bishop John at St. Peter Cathedral on Sunday afternoon with over 80 others from around the diocese. Her confirmation saint is St. Agnes, and Dustin Larson was her sponsor! Please congratulate Anna


