“O my people, I will open your graves and have you rise from them, and bring you back to the land of Israel.” That’s God’s promise to us from our first reading... **He will overcome even the grave itself!**

It seems to me that we live in a culture that tries not to think about the grave, to avoid the reality of death by looking away. It doesn’t change the reality, and I don’t believe it helps us deal with the reality of death. The Church’s clear discipline is that everyone who dies would have a grave, a place of burial, where our mortal remains are committed to the earth. Whether we’re buried in a casket, or in an urn after cremation, there is no provision for anything else ever to happen to a Catholic’s mortal remains. This discipline is rooted in the respect we show the mortal remains of a loved one, and also, I believe, in the practical wisdom that it is important for the living to have a public place so that graves can be visited.

Jesus comes to Bethany and finds that His friend Lazarus has died, and Lazarus’ family and friends are mourning his death. **Jesus Himself weeps.** He then exercises His divine power over even death itself, “Lazarus, come out!” And Lazarus came out, no longer dead, but alive.

The prophet’s promise is fulfilled. **On the last day, Jesus will again cry out, and all who have died will rise from their graves.** All will receive glorified bodies, and we hope to be among that number who will spend eternity in the joy of God’s presence, rather than in eternal separation from God. This fallen world is not our final home, we are strangers here, sojourners, on the way to a better place.

This great miracle sets the stage for what we will begin to celebrate next Sunday, when it is already Palm Sunday! During Holy Week we accompany the Lord during His Passion, so as to rejoice with Him in His Resurrection. Please **plan now to participate fully in the Triduum!**
