St. Anne's Rectory Updates We will be replacing the stained carpet and repainting some of the walls in the coming weeks. Many thanks to Lynn Artmann for organizing this work on short notice.

St. Al's Church Renovation: Work in the sanctuary is almost complete, all that's left is the trim along the wall. On Thursday, July 13, the old carpet and underlying tile will be removed and abated in the vestibule and stairwell so that the new carpet can be installed shortly thereafter. This will leave, in early August: the removal of the old pews and carpet, the abatement of the underlying asbestos-bearing tile, install new flooring (carpet under the pews and side aisles, stone-appearance vinyl tile in the main aisle), and the new pews.

From the desk of Fr. Ben...

“Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. **Take my yoke upon you and learn from me**, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light.” Jesus’ famous and beautiful words in the Gospel make reference to a reality, common in His time, that we are unfamiliar with. Horses or oxen are yoked together to perform important labor. We readily labor fruitlessly, alone, imagining that the Lord expects us to prevail so that we can present Him with our accomplishments... but this is NOT His invitation!

I learned not so long ago that I may in part have been named for one of my grandfather’s last pair of plow horses, Ben and Dan!!! I do not believe my mother was aware of this context at my birth, but I do believe if I had a brother, his name might have Daniel!!! A shared labor can be a labor of love, a loving toil. A man plowing with trusted horses or oxen may come to love him, and perhaps on some level they may come to love him. **Jesus invites us into HIS work... will we join Him, yoked beside Him in love?**

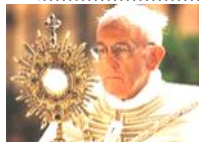
