On this second Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the beautiful **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)**. The readings and prayers of the Mass draw us deeper into the mystery of the Eucharist... and then on Sunday afternoon at 2pm, we have our Corpus Christi procession going from St. Al's to St. Ignatius! Please come out on Sunday to show your devotion to our Eucharistic Lord!

We have received a very great gift in our parishes this weekend: on Friday, Bishop John announced at the Ordination Mass in Marquette that newly-ordained Fr. Dustin Larson will be our new Associate Pastor, starting at St. Al's and St. Anne's on July 2nd! It is an AWESOME blessing for our parishes to have a second priest, and to have Fr. Dustin as part of our community.

After the ordination, I traveled with Sr. Jacqueline and 18 young adults to Winona, MN for a **week of Totus Tuus training**. Those 18 missionaries will be trained for service in our diocese this summer in the Totus Tuus program. Please keep us all in your prayers as we prepare for a summer service in 22 sites!

One of those sites is right here in the Copper Country! **Totus Tuus this summer will be hosted at St. Joseph Church in Lake Linden June 10-15.** If you haven't already registered, please do so this week. Registration forms are available at the parish office.

I am very grateful to Fr. Jose for his coverage this week, and later in June. It is a busy month, and I am grateful to be able to work in these exciting programs... but it is hard to be out of town so much! One of the big reasons we have been blessed with a second priest is the amount of traveling I need to do in my multiple assignments... it's going to make a big difference for me and for you!
