We had a wonderful patronal feast, procession, and parish picnic this past Sunday! Thank you to everyone who participated! A special thank you to Barbara Wells for graciously allowing us to expand over onto her yard, and to everyone who helped set up and take down the tents! I think we have begun something I hope will become a beloved tradition!
