This week is the beautiful solemnity of the Blessed Mother, the Assumption. It is a holy day of obligation, please make every effort to come to one of the three Mass times!

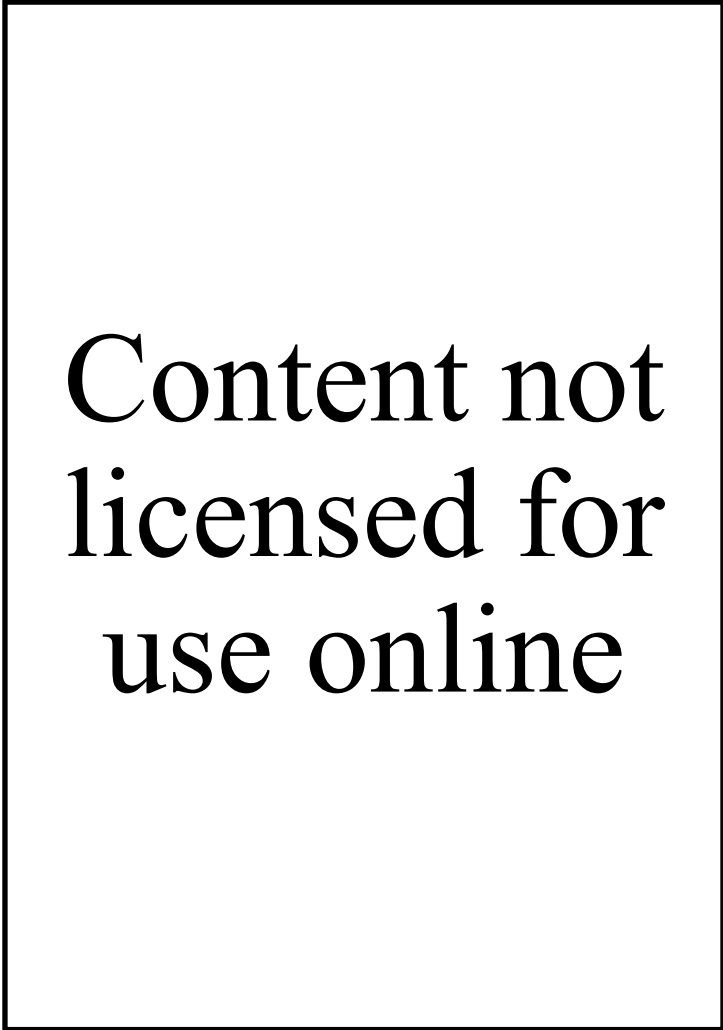

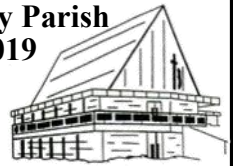

**SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR
