**Words of Wisdom from Bishop Frederic Baraga**

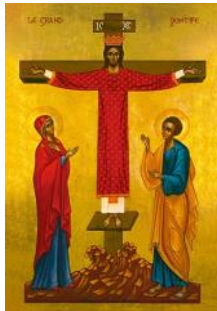
After partaking of a frugal meal, usually consisting of tea and hard dry bread Fr. Baraga would not fail to say his prayers and read his office while his guide prepared his bed of spruce boughs.



Fr. Dustin and I joined Bishop John and nearly 30 priests from around our diocese for training at Marygrove this week. The training is run by the Catholic Leadership Institute, and is called **“Good Leaders, Good Shepherds.”** There are 7 sessions, and we just completed the 3<sup>rd</sup> one. The program is used all over the country, and is designed to give us better self-knowledge as well as formation to lead one-on-one, in teams, in organizations (parishes), and in a multi-organization context.

As I am responsible for two parishes and the vocations office, this training is much needed! It is challenging to think about organizing and leading more efficiently with the simple tools we’re learning, when so much of the time I seem to be just trying to keep my head above water... but I know it’s the right thing to work towards! **Please pray for Fr. Dustin and I, and for Bishop John and our whole presbyterate, as we seek to serve and lead well in these challenging times!**

In our Gospel this Sunday, Jesus tells us: “Rather, whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all. **For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many.**”
