





From the desk of Fr. Ben.. 31 March 2019



"While he was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him, and was filled with compassion. He ran to his son, embraced him and kissed him."

Those are truly beautiful words!!! The prodigal son who has sinned against his father, his family, all that is good and right... this son doesn't make it back on his own, he doesn't understand, but he's inspired to turn in the right direction and begin, to start home! The father closes the gap and offers far more than the son had even hoped to receive!

During this Lenten season we hope by God's grace to turn in the right direction, away from sin, and to turn towards His love and mercy! **He will meet us there**... He does meet us there, long before all is restored, all fixed!

This Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Lent, Lactare Sunday, from the words of the Entrance Antiphon: "Rejoice Jerusalem...!) Our liturgical color is rose, not the penitential violet, but the joyful rose, as Easter is now fast approaching!

Please pray in a special way in these days for all those who are preparing to be baptized at the Easter Vigil, and all those who, already baptized, will come into full communion with the Church! Their journeys are varied and unique, but it is a great joy for us as the Body of Christ to prepare to welcome them!

For the next three weeks we'll have **Stations of the Cross:** 7:30 pm on Tuesdays (we'll begin Adoration right after we finish) and at 12:15 pm on Fridays. We alternate the classic text by St. Alphonsus of Liguori with another beautiful scriptural version.

We are joining other Christian organizations on campus this year in a campaign called "Do you agree with John?" This year Easter is on April 21st, and the Gospel of John has 21 chapters. We have simple pocket versions of the Gospel of John, and we are inviting everyone to read a chapter a day (or 3 pages) in April... and to share these with your friends! We also have Do you agree with John? t-shirts to help promote the campaign! This is a tremendous opportunity to encounter the testimony of the Beloved Disciple, and to share that testimony with others!

Lenten Penance Services continue this week in Hancock, see the Vicariate schedule to the right. There is no better preparation for Easter, no better way to make your Lenten journey fruitful, than a good confession!

This weekend, Fr. Dustin, Sr. Jacqueline, and I will be with college students from across the UP for our Spring Campus Ministry Retreat. Please pray for a time of true conversion and grace! I'm grateful to Fr. Corbin for coming to cover Masses! Next weekend, Fr.
