**Words of Wisdom from Bishop Frederic Baraga**

“The zealous missionary, Mr. Jacker, who already hears confessions and preaches in 4 languages, is now going to learn the fifth, that is the Irish, or better, the Celtic language, because he has many Irishmen who only speak this language. It takes a heroic will for learning such a language.”



Thus the great Caravaggio depicts the *Incredulità di San Tommaso!* “Then [Jesus] said to Thomas, ‘Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe.’ Thomas answered and said to him, ‘My Lord and my God!’”

We know so much of what we know based on our faith in the accuracy and reliability of other people’s testimony. We have good cause to trust the eyewitness testimony of the Apostles and disciples who encountered the Risen Lord Jesus!

Thank you again to everyone who helped with Holy Week liturgies, decorations, Easter Flowers, etc. It takes a lot of hard work! We truly celebrated beautiful liturgies together!
