From the desk of Fr. Ben... 23 June 2019



Two weeks after Pentecost each year we celebrate the great **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ** (Corpus Christi). We meditate upon the mystery of the Lord who gives us Himself completely, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, hidden under the appearance of bread and wine!

At our Corpus Christi Procession THIS Sunday afternoon (2 pm, June 23rd), we'll be welcoming Fr. Joseph's bishop from Ghana!!! Please come show your devotion and love for the Eucharist, and come to welcome this bishop who has so generously sent priests to help in our diocese! **Bishop Joseph Osei-Bonsu** was a member of the International Theological Commission, and also president of the Ghana Bishops' Conference!

The **Second Story Addition** to the rat residence at St. Al's is moving along quite quickly... the walls and roof went up this past week! We hope to have that work done by early November. This is **the first big step in our Multiply the Mission Campaign**. The new second floor will include the relocated priest residence, and 2 new meeting rooms! It will set the stage for subsequent phases including the renovation of the offices, the current rat residence, and the hall downstairs. We have raised over \$960,000.00 in pledges so far, on a goal of \$3,141,592.65, so we've made good progress, but we have a long ways still to go!



Another result of the campaign so far is that we have secured an **expanded FOCUS team for the fall!** Nick and Stefanie will be returning! Allie will be working part-time in graduate student outreach... and we'll be welcoming **THREE NEW MISSIONARIES! Katie, Megan, and Alex** are pictured here at their ongoing training at the Univ. of Mary in Bismarck, ND.

I'll be on the road again this week, a conference in Oklahoma City, an alumni gathering in Dallas, and a visit to the new missionaries up in Bismarck! Fr. Dustin will be at the helm here!

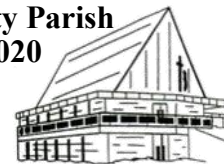
