

From the desk of Fr. Ben... 14 July 2019



It's a classic and perennial question, "Who is my neighbor?" The gist of Jesus' reply should be quite challenging to each of us: it's the person at hand who needs our help, whoever they may be!

That includes the unborn child, the mother in a crisis pregnancy, the immigrant, the person we disagree with politically. If there is a person in front of us who needs help, then that is the neighbor Jesus is calling us to love, to protect, to defend. **That truth doesn't in one step answer every**

question of policy and procedure... it doesn't resolve every detail of the abortion debate, or the immigration debate, or even tensions we experience with our spouses, parents, children, siblings, or in-laws! But it does make clear that we don't get to write anybody off... of no one can we say "That person doesn't deserve respect, care, mercy."

Just NEXT SUNDAY we have St. Anne's Patronal Feast, celebrated this year on Sunday, July 21st!!! Weather permitting, we hope to repeat our rhythm from last year: gather at St. Anne's at 9 am, process to the Shrine, celebrate Mass there, and then follow with a potluck cookout. **Please plan to join us for this beautiful expression of devotion to our patroness, La Bonne Sainte Anne!**

I have included another bulletin insert on **the petition drive to ban dismemberment abortion in our state.** We're working on getting organized for this as a diocese and as a parish. Please read the insert carefully.

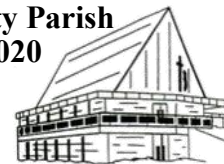
