From the desk of Fr. Ben... 21 July 2019

We have had some hot steamy weather... I find it hard to believe the end of July is fast approaching already! It has been a typically busy summer week.. Fr. Dustin spent the week at Catholic Summer Camp south of Shingleton, helping with a BIG group of children and youth. I was on the road with Rhen Tuesday –Thursday for St. Al's events in Madison and Milwaukee.

It has been a tough week as we've walked with two tragedies. On Monday we offered a **Memorial Mass for Kevin Lobo**, the Michigan Tech grad student who drowned in Canyon Falls on July 5th. Kevin, from India, was from a Catholic background. Please pray for his eternal repose, and also for his family. As I type this, I'm not sure if his body has reached India for a funeral Mass there and burial.

As many of you may have seen on Facebook or email, there was also a **tragic car accident in Wyoming on Monday night, July 15th.** The driver, **Steven Biddle**, was killed in the crash. He was a campus minister at WMU, and engaged to be married on July 27. Two St. Al's alumni were also in the vehicle, **Alex Gill** and **Vincent McLain**. Vincent was not seriously injured, but as of this Friday morning (July 19), Alex is in very critical condition in the hospital in Denver. After graduating from Michigan Tech in 2016, Alex served two years as a FOCUS missionary at UW-Platteville, and having finished his service, has been working on starting up his Computer Science career. Please pray for everyone involved.

In much more joyful news, this Sunday is the celebration of **St. Anne's Patronal Feast.** We gather at St. Anne's at 9 am, process to the Shrine, celebrate Mass there, and then follow with a potluck cookout. **Please plan to join us for this beautiful expression of devotion to our patroness, La Bonne Sainte Anne!**

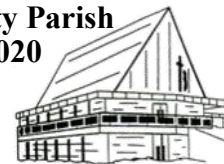
