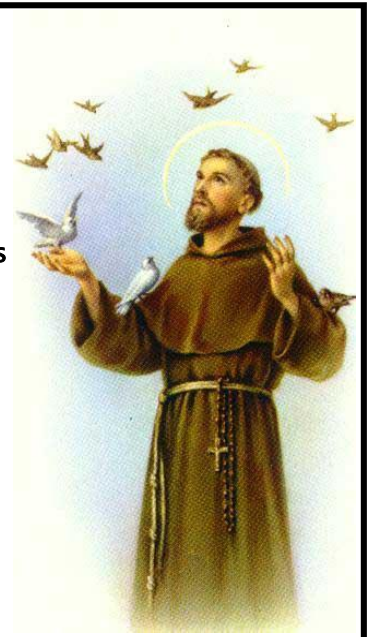

Over 50 years ago, Squires in Mexico initiated a running of the rose as an activity to show respect and to edify Our Lady of Guadalupe. The fourth Rose begins in Virginia moving south through Florida and then turning westward along the Gulf Coast.
