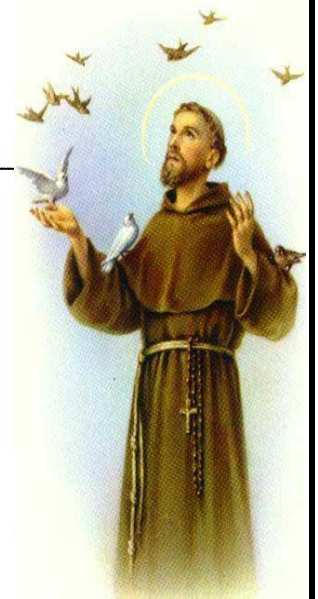



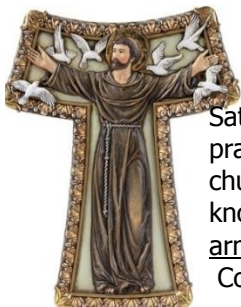
Catholic Social Teaching Corner:
