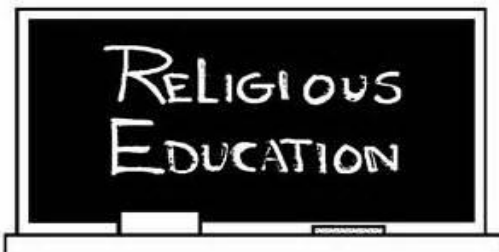


DCCW BRAZOS VALLEY AUGUST MEETING
