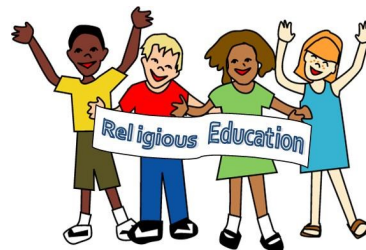

Jesus said, “Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things.”

My dear parishioners,

The evangelist Luke in his gospel frequently shows women in places of honor. This Sunday’s gospel, he presents Mary as sitting at Jesus’ feet to receive his teaching, the posture of a disciple, a man’s role during Jesus time. Mary’s presumptuous posture and the attention she was receiving may have embarrassed Martha. Martha may have suspected that Jesus loved her “spiritual” sister better than herself and that Jesus had little regard for the mundane work she was doing in the kitchen. Hence, it is no wonder that Martha was distracted. Her hands were busy but her resentments were busier. How are we to understand the complementarities of Martha’s hospitality in meeting Jesus’ need for food, and Mary’s longing for personal communion with him? Our love of God must become incarnate in whatever we do to meet the needs of others. *Thus our good work- whether cooking a meal or exercising our civil rights (voting for a bill), becomes a sacrament or an effective sign of our self-giving love.*

As Luke honors women in his gospel, we are going to honor our Patron Saint Anne here at our Parish by having a Novena starting from July 18th to July 26th, when the actual feast of St. Anne is to be celebrated. The novena is done soon after the 9am mass. We are delighted that our Bishop Robert McManus comes to our parish on Saturday, July 23rd to celebrate the Eucharist at the 5:00pm to honor St. Anne and hence I would encourage all of you to come and participate and honor her and receive her blessings. I also encourage all of you to give your support in any way possible to make this event special and spiritual.
