PARISH LIFE and STEWARDSHIP

A Note to Parishioners:

Jesus said to them in reply,
“My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and act on it.” (Luke 8:21)

As I was reflecting on the above scriptural reading on Tuesday (09/20), I came to realize how wonderful and privileged we are that we are called sisters and brothers of Jesus when we hear the word of God and act on it.

We know that the etymological meaning of ‘family’ is coming from the Latin word, *familia*, which means, a family or the members of a household. According to Catholic Culture Dictionary, the family is a group of persons who are related by marriage or blood and who typically include a father, mother and children. A family is a natural society whose right to existence and support is provided by divine law. According to the Second Vatican Council, “the family is the foundation of society,” (The Church in the Modern World, II, 52). “In addition to the natural family, the Church recognizes also the supernatural family of the diocese and of a religious community, whose members are to cooperate for the up building of the Body of Christ,” (Decree on the Bishop’s Pastoral Office, 34; and Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, 43).

Jesus teaches His disciples a truth about the kingdom of God that the **deepest relationship of life** is not merely a blood relationship. He changes the order of relationships and shows that true kinship is not just a matter of flesh and blood. He pointed to another higher reality of spiritual kinship, that is, the **family of God**.

So in this sense, Christianity is more than doctrine, precepts and commandments. It is first and foremost a relationship, a relationship of love and unity with the Trinitarian God and with all who belong to God as His adopted children. We became God’s adopted children when we were baptized. As His adopted children, therefore, others are our brothers and sisters.

I am sure most of you experienced the relationship of love and unity when we had the picnic last weekend. **I would like to express my sincere thanks to all who coordinated and worked hard to make this picnic a life giving one.** Most of us were concerned whether it would rain on that day but because of your fervent prayers, God had given us a beautiful day to enjoy His blessings. **I also would like to thank all the parents who registered their children for Religious Education and are willing to guide them to experience God’s blessings in the St. Anne parish family.** Also, I express my sincere thanks to all the teachers for their willingness to share their faith with our children during this year.



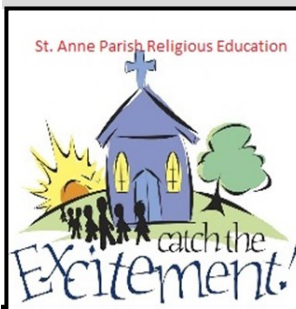

WELCOME BACK TO OUR CHILDREN, PARENTS, CATECHISTS AND CATECHIST ASSISTANTS

It is great to be back preparing for another year in our religious education program! We hope you have all had an enjoyable and safe summer and look forward to growing in Christ with you and your family this year!

First Reconciliation/First Communion Sacrament Program

Baptized children receiving First Reconciliation and First Communion this year will use RCL Benzinger's We Celebrate the Eucharist text.

Children in the Second Year of Sacrament Preparation meet two Sundays a month from 9-10:30AM and will attend the 10:30AM Mass with an adult family member.

Grades 1 – 6 Religious Education Program

Children in Grades 1 – 6 follow Sadlier's We Believe, Project Disciple text.

Grade 1-2 (first year of sacrament preparation) Sunday 9-10:30AM or Monday 4-5:30PM [meets once a month]

Grade 3 Sunday 9-10:30 or Monday 4-5:30PM [meets once a month]

Grade 4-5 Sunday 4-5:30PM or Monday 4-5:30PM [meets once a month]

Grade 6 Monday 7-8:30PM or Tuesday 4-5:30PM [meets once a month]

Grades 7 – 8 Religious Education Program

Youth in Grades 7 – 8 use Sadlier's We Live Our Faith text. We will also incorporate parts of Ascension Press' Theology of the Body for Middle School (a text based on St. John Paul II's reflections on the beauty and dignity of the human body) later in the year. We will introduce this text to parents at a meeting - date to be announced.

Grades 7-8 meet Monday 7-8:30PM or Tuesday 4-5:30PM once a month

Grades 9-10 Religious Education Program

Teens in Grades 9 and 10 use the diocesan suggested Ave Maria Press' Catholic Essentials. The High School program requires the completion of two years of Confirmation Preparation. Students in the first year of Confirmation Preparation attend classes once a month on Sunday evening from 7-8:30PM.

Confirmation Program

For teens in the second year of Confirmation Preparation. These students meet twice a month, once on Sunday evening from 7-8:30PM and additionally on a different Sunday morning from 9:00-10:30AM. The morning classes include breakfast at the beginning of the session, students end class by attending the 10:30AM Mass together.
