In this weekend's Gospel reading,
Matthew 5:38-48, if we take it literally, we would

encouragement for evil. This isn't what Jesus had in
mind; His vivid examples illustrate that His disciples' need to give
up any sense of entitlement to personal revenge, to be purged of
the motivation of personal vengeance. By asking them to turn the
other cheek, Jesus meant that His disciples should be motivated
by love and a desire for the redemption and forgiveness of
offenders—even when opposing their actions.


