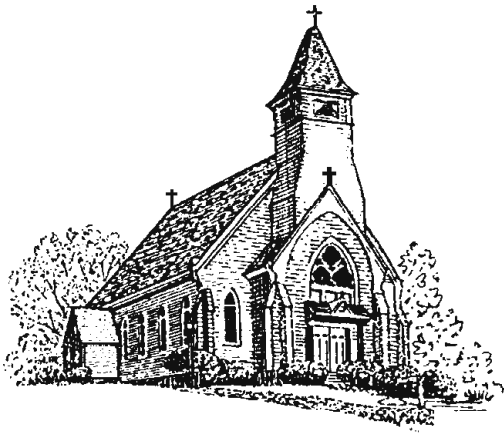

ST. ANNE PARISH MISSION STATEMENT
We, the people of St. Anne Parish, Southborough, in the Diocese of Worcester are called through Baptism to become one faith family. We commit ourselves to embody the presence of Christ in Word and Sacrament; by using our ministries to welcome all who are seeking Jesus and to share in the life and work of our Catholic faith. In the spirit and truth of the Holy Trinity, we will use our time, talents and treasure to answer God's command to love one another as He has loved us, in holy worship, prayer, Catechetical formation for all, evangelization and service to others.

This season of Ordinary Time begins with two lavish feasts: *The Most Holy Trinity* and *The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)* next Sunday.

Today's reading from Matthew 28:16-20, known as The Great Commission, is not a beginning, but the conclusion of his Gospel. These are the final words of Jesus to the eleven. The crucifixion and resurrection have already taken place. On this mountaintop encounter with Jesus, the disciples do two things: they worship and they doubt. Even at this point, some of the disciples doubted. That should give us comfort to all of us today, and ease any guilt we have about our doubt.

Jesus' message to them is clear and authoritative: to go teach, baptize, and make disciples of everyone they meet... to be inclusive of ALL nations...

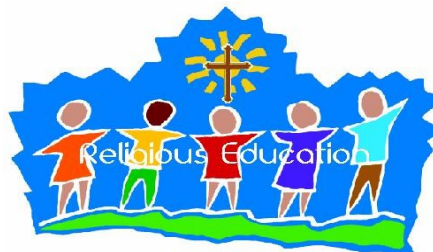
Feast of the Most Holy Trinity
