1. Log in to SchoolSpeak. Call the school office if you need your user name and password.
 2. Click on your log-in name in the upper right-hand corner.
 3. Update your parent profile with current contact information.
 4. Click on "Update Family" in the upper right-hand corner to update profiles of your spouse and all children.
- The student profiles include very important emergency contact and medical information along with some of the permission forms that were previously included in your back-to-school packets!
