EIM Workshop will be held on **Thursday February 28 at 7PM** in the Divine Providence Center. You **MUST** submit your EIM Application and register **ONLINE** before this date. **NO WALKINS** will be accepted.

All clergy, religious, seminarians and employees, and adult volunteers serving in a ministry requiring EIM compliance, must attend an EIM Workshop every 3 years. **Workshop attendees must pre-register at least 24 hours before Workshop start time – walkins are no longer admitted.** To find the schedule, and Sign Up for a Workshop (bottom right of your account page), login to your EIM account at eappsdb.com/austin. If you don't recall your User ID/Password, please use the Alternate Login option. If you have never submitted an EIM application (required for employees, and adult volunteers serving in any ministry requiring EIM compliance), use the above link to create your EIM account and complete the application. Contact your parish EIM site administrator *Joanne Selucky* if you need to complete a paper EIM application or need other assistance with EIM compliance matters.

On January 31, the Diocese of Austin published the names of clerics who have been credibly accused of committing sexual abuse against minors on its website, austindiocese.org. The list was compiled with the assistance of outside professionals and staff members who reviewed 70 years of archived documents. Moving forward, the list will be amended if other credible allegations are received. **Please contact the diocese at (512) 949-2400** if you have reason to believe a name is missing from this list. **Questions about the list should also be directed to the diocese. If you have suffered sexual abuse, please report the abuse to law enforcement authorities.** If the sexual abuse occurred by a minister of the church, please also contact the Office of Ethics and Integrity in Ministry. Bishop Joe S. Vásquez asks that you join him in prayer for the victims and their families.
