**BIG NEWS** – Beginning in April the physical location of the Granger Food Pantry will be relocated to the Brethren Church in Granger. This church is located across from SSCM. The First United Methodist Church will be closing their church and the Brethren Administration was kind enough to let us use their facilities for food storage and distribution. We look forward to serving the folks in this area at our new location.
