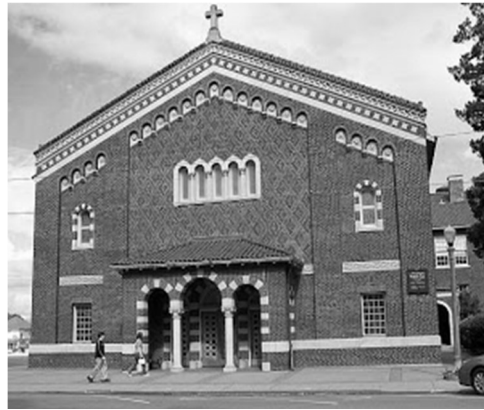

Fellow Parishioners,

Our formal fund drive campaign kick-off has begun with a series of six informational meetings for all parishioners. The dates are in the bulletin but the initial meetings occurred on February 10th and February 11th. There are 4 more meetings scheduled, with the next meeting on Thursday, February 15th from 6:30 to 8:00 pm in Hensen Hall. Please consider attending one of these meetings to learn more about the maintenance issues we face.

In March, the quarterly debt reduction envelope will be replaced with a monthly Maintenance Matters envelope. This envelope will run at least thru the end of the Maintenance campaign (December 2020). Depending on how we do completing the many projects it may be discontinued or remain.

All Parishioners will receive a mailer about the maintenance campaign, a pledge form and a return envelope in mid-March. If you do not receive a mailer by March 15th please call the parish office. Please be sure to return your pledge form no later than the end of April. The pledge form contains a commitment for talent and time as well as financial support over the three year campaign.

The maintenance fund drive committee continues to meet twice monthly on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday's at 5:30 pm in the Parish Offices. Please feel free to attend.

A **second committee** is being formed and consists of individuals who have maintenance and construction experience. If you have experience or a construction business please let us know. Just email Duane at dpschireman@gmail.com or call the parish office and leave your name with Mary Chris.

FAQs

When does the fund drive start and when will it end?

The maintenance fund drive will start about January of 2018 and conclude no later than December of 2020.

Is the OLPH school building [now the Faith Formation Center] part of the fund drive?

No. There are a few smaller maintenance items that are required for safety reasons. The Church, Hensen Hall, and the Office are the main focus of the maintenance list.

Is the “old” convent part of the maintenance fund drive?

No. Since 1999, the building has been utilized by “The Family Shelter” (Interfaith Association of Northwest Washington) to support 11 families at a time in their transition from homelessness to permanent housing. The long term use of the facility will be taken up with the new pastor in the fall of 2018. The facility is under a lease until June of 2019.
