

St. Timothy Parish Confirmation Preparation ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES



FOR CANDIDATES

- Pray! with others at mass and privately at home. During your preparation, deepen your relationships with God and others, especially your parents and those less fortunate.
- Serve! Immerse yourself in the works of mercy. Find God in yourself and those around you.
- Ask questions—of your catechist, your parents, your sponsor, and of God.
- Attend all classes; if you miss a class, arrange with your catechist or Mary Ellen to make up the work.
- Show your personal commitment to the preparation process by completing all the required assignments and projects.
- Attend all special events, such as the Retreat, the Night of Reconciliation, and the Confirmation Rehearsal.
- Schedule your Confirmation Interview to personally discuss your preparation for Confirmation with a pastoral leader at the parish.
- On the day of your Confirmation, arrive with your Sponsor 45 minutes prior to the start of Mass.

FOR PARENTS

- Intentionally serve as your child's primary faith role model. Demonstrate in word and deed how you bring your faith to bear on your life.
- Help your child explore her/his own commitment to God and our common Roman Catholic faith.
- Pray with and for your child.
- Assist your child (and support your child's catechist) by reminding him/her to complete projects and assignments.
- Help your child attend class faithfully.

FOR SPONSORS

- Provide spiritual guidance and support to your Confirmation Candidate, both before and after their Confirmation; pray for her/him often.
- Encourage your Candidate to always be the person God created him/her to be.
- Attend the Commissioning Service, Jan. 28, 2018 & rehearsal 2019 with your Candidate.
- On the day of Confirmation, arrive 45 minutes prior to the start of Mass.
