

New Student Admission Information

Registration for each academic year begins in February at Saint Maria Goretti Catholic School. We ask families to apply online as it simplifies submission and provides parents a tool for tracking the status of their admission. A non-refundable fee of \$25 must be submitted with each student online application. The online application link is on the school website at www.smgschool.org/new-students. Our RenWeb district code is SMGT-TX.

To begin the online application process, please use the link Create an Account at www.smgschool.org/new-students. This account will be used to login to the New Student Application and ParentsWeb for your child. PLEASE REMEMBER THIS LOGIN. Once your application is processed, you will receive a confirmation email containing instructions for completion of enrollment. To complete the enrollment process for new students, you will access using your existing login.

To access ParentsWeb:

- Go to <http://www.renweb.com>
- Select Logins from the menu bar and ParentsWeb Login from the drop-down menu.
- Enter your username and password (If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.)
- After logging in, click on the Family Information button on the left.
- Click on the Enrollment/Reenrollment button

The instructions and enrollment checklist page of the enrollment packet contains supplemental enrollment forms that must also be submitted.

All prospective new students are required to provide the following items:

1. A completed online application and online enrollment packet
2. Registration fee paid in FACTS
3. Birth certificate, Baptismal and First Eucharist certificates, if applicable
4. Current immunization record
5. Diocesan school physical form signed by a physician, dated after June 1, due by August 1
6. A complete transcript of grades and standardized test scores
7. Interview with the principal prior to acceptance
