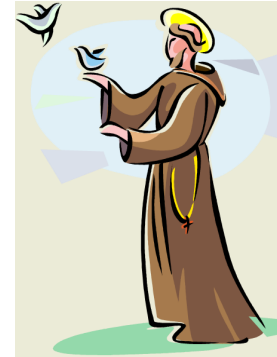

Reading I, Deuteronomy 26:4-10

⁴ 'The priest will then take the basket from your hand and lay it before the altar of Yahweh your God.

⁵ In the presence of Yahweh your God, you will then pronounce these words: "My father was a wandering Aramaean, who went down to Egypt with a small group of men, and stayed there, until he there became a great, powerful and numerous nation.

⁶ The Egyptians ill-treated us, they oppressed us and inflicted harsh slavery on us.

⁷ But we called on Yahweh, God of our ancestors. Yahweh heard our voice and saw our misery, our toil and our oppression;

⁸ and Yahweh brought us out of Egypt with mighty hand and outstretched arm, with great terror, and with signs and wonders.

⁹ He brought us here and has given us this country, a country flowing with milk and honey.

¹⁰ Hence, I now bring the first-fruits of the soil that you, Yahweh, have given me." 'You will then lay them before Yahweh your God, and prostrate yourself in the presence of Yahweh your God.
