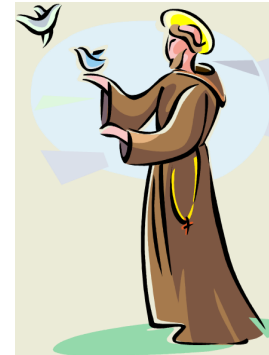

Reading 1, Acts 5:12-16

¹² The [apostles](#) worked many signs and miracles among the people. One in heart, they all used to meet in the Portico of Solomon.
