**From the desk of Fr. James*****"The Most Treacherous Adversary"***

By and large, modern Christians do not believe in the existence of Satan, which is his greatest victory and his most cunning trick. Satan has succeeded in convincing us that he does not exist. Thus he has proved his real nature; a cunning deceiver. Jesus called him the father of lies (Jn 8:44). He is the great adversary of God and humanity. Satan's deception is evident in today's first reading. Jesus' mission of establishing the Kingdom of God is directly linked to struggle against this adversary. He, the enemy, deceives people, misguides them and leads them astray, putting in jeopardy God's plan for humanity. He even tried to tempt Jesus, the Son of God, to deviate from His God-given mission. He apparently succeeded when he got his agents to crucify Jesus but Satan during temptation, won a definitive victory with the resurrection. But the Devil continues his evil activity of deception and destruction. The warfare between the Son of Man, who sows good seeds in the world, and the enemy, who sows weeds, will continue till the end (Mt 13:38-39). Who actually controls my mind, thoughts and desires: The Holy Spirit or the Evil Spirit?
