Come and join us for an Ecumenical Prayer Service here at St. Basil’s this Sunday, **January 20, 2019** at 4:00 p.m. The theme for the 2019 Week of Prayer for Christian Unity comes to us from Indonesia: “Justice, and only justice, you shall pursue” (Deuteronomy 16:18-20). This year’s theme calls us to move from shared prayer to shared action. Drawing on the traditional values of *Bhineka Tunggal Ika (Unity in Diversity)* and *gotong royong (living in solidarity and by collaboration)*, Indonesian Christians invite us to be a united witness, and an agent of Christ’s healing grace in a broken world, by making specific commitments to justice, equality, and unity.
