LITURGY CORNER

What resources provide the guidelines for our liturgies?

There are two primary books which are used when liturgy is celebrated: (1) the *Lectionary* and *Book of the Gospels* from which the assigned readings are proclaimed. There is a Sundays and Solemnities lectionary, a ritual and votive Masses one, a weekday lectionary and a children's lectionary. (2) *The Roman Missal* contains all the prayers and instructions for liturgical celebrations. To accompany the Roman Missal there is the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (GIRM) which is the 'how to' instruction guide. It is comprehensive and applies to the universal church. In Canada we also have Pastoral Notes which are specific to Canadian dioceses and parishes. In addition there are specific ritual books for other celebrations e.g. Rite of Baptism; Order of Christian Funerals; Rite of Marriage; Rite of Confirmation; Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, etc.

A RESTORED FOUNDATION FOR THE FUTURE

Campaign Update #9 FINAL REPORT

1)-Since launching the campaign, the parish has surpassed our FUND-RAISING goal of \$470,000 August 31, 2017 by an additional \$59,305 for a total of \$529,305. Expenditures are expected to be \$529,000.

2)-There were several amendments to the scope of the original project (Bell Tower, Roof Membranes and some electrical work) all projects have or are expected to be on budget.

3)-The remaining work includes approximately \$110,000 of electrical work and \$10,000 for the rectory.

4)-The reporting of the remainder spending under the project will be included with the report on the capital spending for the campaign to replace the boiler and elevator.
