ELEVATOR UPDATE

The present elevator is no longer being supported by the manufacturer. We were advised by the servicing company to plan on replacing it in 2019. Our consulting structural engineer and architect prepared the specifications for a replacement elevator which were sent out for tender. We received several replies and submitted them to the archdiocese for approval, which has been received. The archdiocese approved a fund raising campaign. The elevator will be removed after Easter. The new elevator will be installed and tested six to eight weeks later.
