LITURGY CORNER

Holy Water

During the fifty days of Easter it is particularly appropriate to remember and acknowledge our baptism. During the Sundays of Easter the Sprinkling Rite (Asperges) can replace the penitential act at the beginning of Mass as a tactile reminder of our baptism into the life and death of Jesus Christ our risen Lord. Similarly, Catholics often acknowledge their belief in the triune God by blessing themselves with holy water upon entering or leaving the worship space. Sometimes people even take the blessed holy water from the Vigil to have at home. The use of holy water is called a sacramental. Other sacramentals are wedding rings, ashes imposed on Ash Wednesday, religious vows and the blessings of objects or people.

“Tips For Saving Water”

If washing dishes, put water in the sink rather than letting the tap run while washing.
