LITURGY CORNER

Presences of Christ

During Sunday Mass the church (*Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy*, #7) teaches us that Christ is present in four modes:

- 1)-In the **assembly** gathered to worship: "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there I am in their midst (Matthew 18:20). How do we recognize ourselves as the body of Christ?
- 2)-In the **Word** proclaimed: so how we proclaim and praise is of the utmost importance, from the quality of the sound system to the preparation of the lectors and cantor.
- 3)-In the **Eucharist**: the consecrated elements of bread and wine; Augustine said in his Sermon # 272, "Be what you see; receive who you are." Be bread broken for others=the Body of Christ; receive, be nourished by the Body of Christ.
- 4)-In the **person of the priest** when he is presiding at Mass.
