Read with your children: 1 Kings 19:1-15a

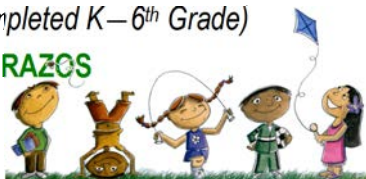

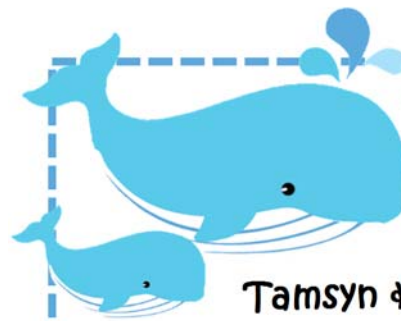
