A New Place to Rest Along the Way

The Caring Support Committee focuses its attention and efforts on providing for the needs of our community of faith. It is our desire and mission to nurture the spirits, hearts, health, and minds of our church family in whatever ways we see and believe can be helpful.

When it comes to navigating the long halls between the sanctuary and Fellowship Hall, we learned that seating midway to pause and "perch" or "rest and catch a breath" would make the trek "friendlier," especially, to those with mobility limits! We made a request to Property Committee. They immediately identified a means to provide an extra way station in the niche near the sloped ramp leading to Fellowship Hall. A longer sanctuary pew (previously removed from the sanctuary to provide space for wheelchairs and in storage) was moved to replace the shorter pew in front of the church office window. The shorter pew was then moved to the niche between the church office and Fellowship Hall (Carter Creek Parkway side) in place of the credenza. The credenza with church informational brochures is now located under the New Member Information Bulletin Board.

The committee is grateful to YUNIOR TORRES CAMARGO, CHERYL MORENO, JIM NACHLINGER, KEITH HALSELL, TED FOOTE, KAREN BERG, and to ALL members of the PROPERTY COMMITTEE for promptly making this much improved accessibility a reality.
