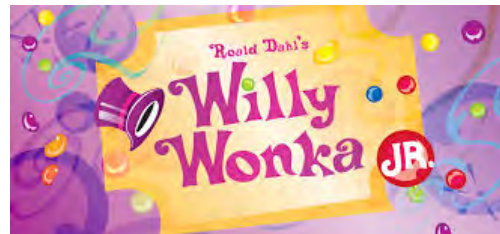
Catholic Schools Week
