Safe Environment Classes and Fingerprinting

The Diocese of St. Venice requires that all Volunteers attend a Safe Environment class and complete background screening prior to volunteering at St. Joseph Catholic School. If you are planning to assist with class parties, chaperone field trips, or assist with activities during the school year, these procedures are mandatory.

LUNCH PERIODS FOR 2017 – 2018

Grades 5 – 8 11:45 Grades K – 4 12:30 (K - 4 students bring a morning snack)

- Students may bring their lunch to school or order lunch through Nutrition Kitchen.
- Students who bring their lunch should bring needed utensils and a paper towel or napkin to use during lunch.
- Please do not bring lunch items in glass containers or glass jars.
- Please do not have food delivered by outside vendors to the office or Parish Center, except in the case on an emergency.
- Parents or guardians may join their child/children for lunch. For safety, we ask all adults to check in at the school office before going to the Parish Center.

Students may bring their items to school on August 9th.

Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

Arrival

The south side of the school is for car drop-off only. No parking is allowed. The north (Parish Center) side of the school is for parents who wish to park and walk students to the classroom, or onto the grounds, in the morning.

Both the north and south side gates will be opened in the morning. After 8:00 A.M., entry is available only through the south gate and anyone entering the campus must sign in at the school office. Students and teachers have been instructed NOT to open the gates for anyone.

Please do not ask students or teachers to break this rule. It is unfair and inappropriate to have them decide who is safe and who is not.

Dismissal

The south side of the school is the sole entrance for all parents picking up students at dismissal, between 2:45 – 3:15. There is no parking during dismissal, and parents/guardians may not leave their vehicles at any time.

All families are asked to display their family name by using the hang tag provided by the school. The hang tag is to be hung from the review mirror with the family name visible.

Please follow the following procedure for picking up students during dismissal:

- 1. Enter parking lot via 33rd Avenue/ south entrance.
- 2. Follow cone-lined route through south parking lot.
- 3. Continue west to playground fence.
- 4. Turn right to head north along playground driveway.
- 5. Turn right to head east on roadway between school and Parish Center.
- 6. Stop at north parking gate to load student passengers. They will be waiting for you with a staff member and safety patrol.
- 7. After exiting the gate, turn left to follow cone-lined route through north parking lot.
 - A. To Exit to the South Turn right at the corner of the church building, before the light, and then left at the church parking lot exit to head south onto 26th Street West.
 - B. To Exit to the East Exit straight ahead to the light. When the light signals green, continue straight through the intersection to head east on 30th Avenue West.
 - C. To Exit to the North Exit straight ahead, veering to the left to enter the left exit at the light. When the light signals green, turn left to head north onto 26th Street West.
- Homeroom teachers should be advised in writing if a student is to go home by a different means on a given day.
- Students may not be picked up at any other location on campus during dismissal.
- Parents may not park and meet students during dismissal. Parents who arrive on campus for after school conferences, and/or meetings, should plan to arrive/depart before or after dismissal.
- For the safety of all students, no parking or entry/ of the building will be permitted between 2:45 3:15, since all staff members are actively engaged in a safe dismissal for all students. If you need to stop in the office, please wait until dismissal has been completed.

Card Payments After entering your card information, *do not close your browser prior to receiving the confirmation display or your order may be interrupted and not fully processed.* If a confirmation page is not displayed, do not attempt to enter payment again, as this may result in duplicate charges.

NEED TO CHANGE or CANCEL YOUR ORDER?

Changes can be made during the open ordering period, meaning if the date of service has not occurred and until 6pm the evening prior. No refunds will be given, however, credits for cancellations will be applied to your next order. Once the ordering period has closed, your order is final.

FORGOT TO PLACE YOUR ORDER?

After the ordering period has closed, late orders are NOT accepted. *Note: orderlunches.com is not authorized to allow any orders after the menu has closed.*

DIETARY LIMITATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS:
