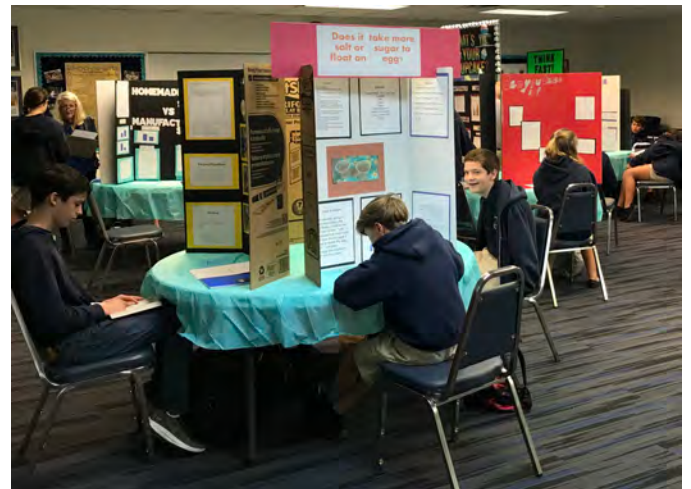
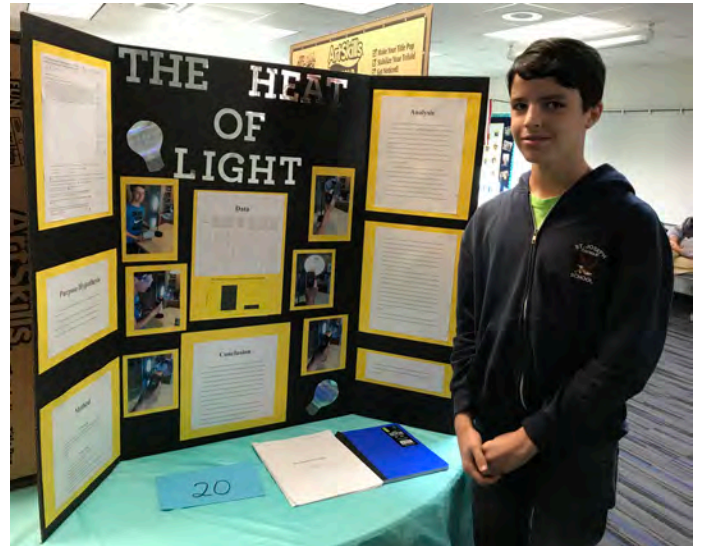

When does the Pizza Contest begin?

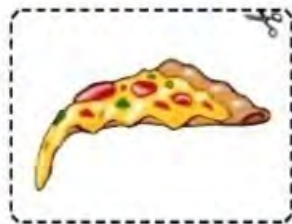
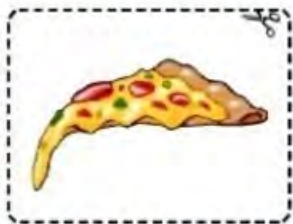
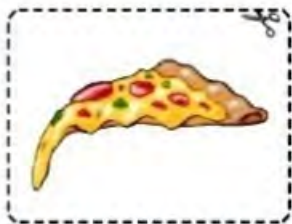
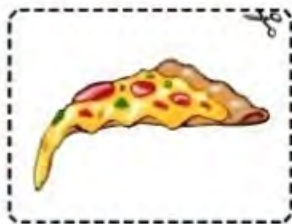
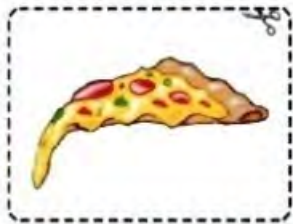
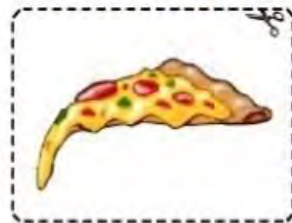
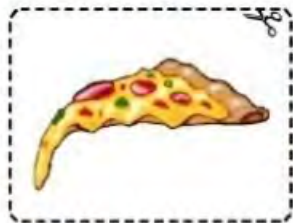
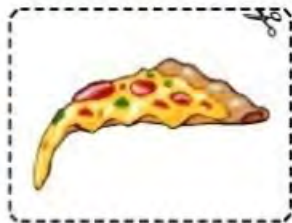
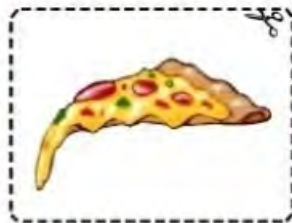
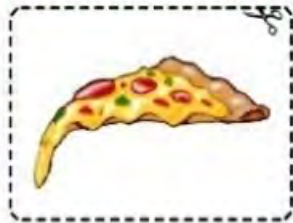
