Mrs. Kinney:

We have decided on the reading program Wonders. This particular reading program is priced out about \$50,000. I feel very confident we can get it to 35,000. With that being said and something I see is probable to get that amount lower we would only be asking so we are asking \$10,000 from H&S. This program is equipped with an electronic component so if a child needs the test read to them we have that option.

One other amount we are asking for is \$20,000. This would cover other cost we are looking at is from Amy Volstead to cover new IPADS. We typically get a lifespan of 4 years from our IPADS. Our IPADS are 6 years old and they can not be updated. Mrs. Kinney was asked the question "What is the difference in use between IPADS and Chrome books. IPADS are used for more repetition and in the younger grades K-5. Chrome books are used more in the 5-8th grade. There are currently about 5 IPads per classroom in grades K-5. Another option that we could consider for a donation is Pillars. This organization helped fund the Promethean boards which will also need to be upgraded at some point. More questions were asked at this time so we felt it would be helpful if Amy Volstead came down to the meeting to help better understand the reasoning to upgrade these systems.

~Chrome Books need an account for which we do not have that for the little ones so they are not able to use them. Middle school is basically only use the chrome books. Literacy and math like AR test are done on Chrome books.

~IPADS - K-5 typically use the IPADS more. There are apps that they use and are more friendly to them. New IPADS are running around \$299
