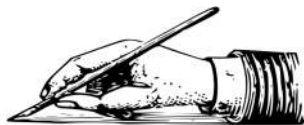

Dear family,

Anyone who has lived some knows the feeling of being defeated by life. Like the person in today's Gospel, sometimes we find ourselves crushed by life. Both stripped to vulnerability and beaten by defeat, we sometimes find ourselves lying half-dead. Whether introverted or extroverted, whether on large or small scales there exists not one honest person who hasn't hit the brokenness and limits of this world like a brick wall. This is assumed, what's not assumed is forgiveness, kindness, compassion and mercy. However, this is exactly where the Christian comes on the scene. Jesus reminds us that we all have a duty to reach out to those who are hurting the most and bind their wounds. And lest we become too smug in our track record or triumphs, Jesus uses this parable to indicate that all of us are the man beaten, stripped and lying half dead. We are wounded healers, never above those we are called to serve, but serving with compassion because of our own scars: a reminder we were once saved through God's compassion and mercy. So go and do likewise!
