Year of Mercy Corner:

If not afflicted yourself, you may know someone who has a poor self-image. As harsh as people's words and actions can be at times, many feel paralyzed and are afraid to let their gifts and talents shine forth. During this year of mercy, it's important we remind these persons that the only opinion that matters is God's. Or better yet, we should remind people to ask God how He thinks of them. Perhaps one of the most powerful thoughts we can call to mind is that the day we were baptized, God accepted us as we were and taking us under His wings and gave us great gifts. I believe more would find purpose and zeal for living their life when they are reminded by their fellow Christians that we are a people called and commissioned by a God who makes us worthy. If God has called you, what right has anyone to call you anything but blest?!

"Beloved: I remind you, to stir into flame the gift of God that you have through the imposition of my hands. For God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather of power and love and self-control."

Dear family,

It is a particular pain we experience when a young person dies, this is a pain our community knows all too well. Further, it is an added loss when the person lost showed signs of a great gift that could have been shared with the world. Surely, though there is no greater tragedy than a person who continually allows his or her gifts to go unused. In terms of God-given talents, a person who does not use them are the walking dead among us. I wonder if this was on G. K. Chesterton's mind when he said, "Christianity has not been tried and found wanting, it has not been tried. The first Christians shook the world around them by heroic acts of faith, hope and love to where even their persecutors had to take notice. So what about today's Church, today's Catholics? St. Paul gives us the great exhortation in our second reading, "...stir into flame the gift of God that you have through the imposition of my hands." Essentially, for St. Paul reminds us that we are all sitting on a gold mine of great gifts and talent afforded us by the sacramental life. What is holding you back? You have a great light within you, why not let it out?!
