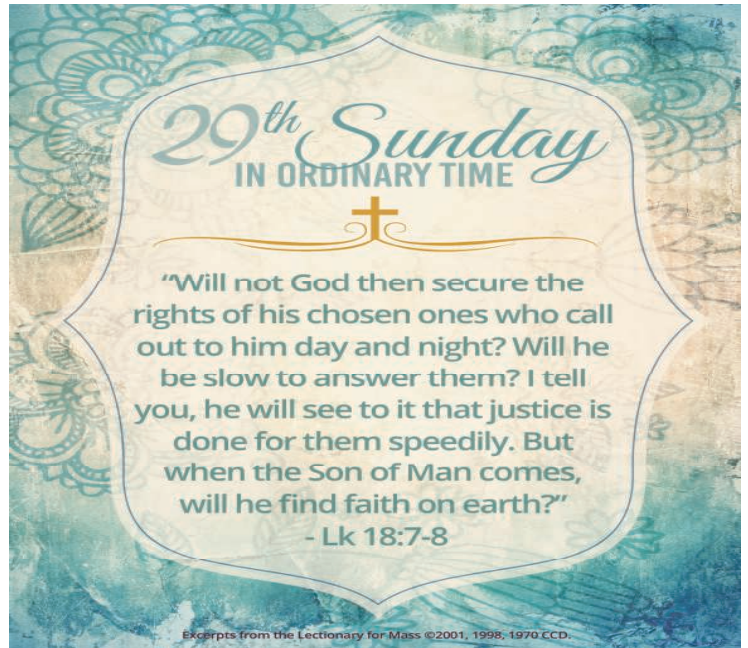

Year of Mercy Corner:

Sometimes the most powerful expressions of mercy can be found in the simple ways we fulfill our responsibilities. Those that live in this world are no strangers to corruption and in some ways many have become cynical to the point of expecting corrupt results or at least negligent ones. As Christians, we are called to take the values of Christ into the public square and this often begins not with decisive, earth-shattering moves, but with a constant and consistent dedication by every Christian and person of good will to give each person their attention and just treatment so as to continue a cycle of justice and mercy. This is needed now more than ever.

Dear family,

Today’s Gospel gives us an image we are all too familiar with: corruption in positions of power. This judge “who neither feared God nor respected any human being” brings a caricatured mental image of the politicians or CEOs we often hear about who exploit others in one way or another. For whatever particular reason this judge did not rend the widow’s decision sooner is up in the air. It is safe to say that whatever the reason for his procrastination, he did not take the gravity of his responsibility seriously. He is only moved to act when the woman burdens and bothers him with her constant insistence that he help her. Then Jesus makes a clear distinction that His Father is so much different than this man, which is obvious. What’s not so obvious or at least often forgotten is that since God is all good and loving, we should never fail to seek out his help and present him with our needs. Unlike this judge, the Just Judge never sees us a burdens and will always render justice where it is due. No matter the commonality of corruption we face, we must fight for justice in this world alongside our God who always treats us fairly and with love, despite our sometimes unfair rejection of His love
