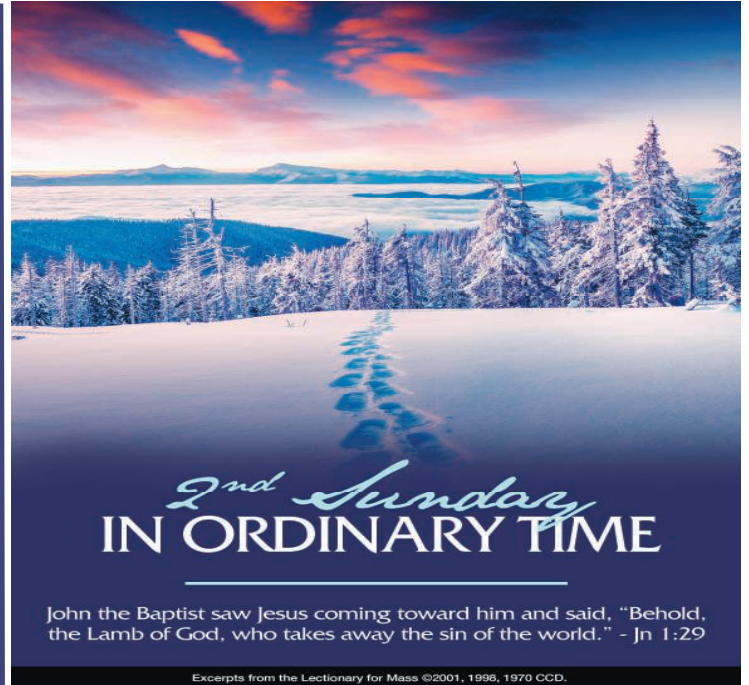

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear family,

“Behold, the Lamb of God...” These famous words uttered first by St. John the Baptist and now spoken to believers at every Mass by the priest are important. Certainly they are important enough to be repeated, but why? On one hand it is overall an important piece of news to proclaim: that God Himself is in our

midst. But it’s also important for us to realize that the action of calling out God’s presence is important and necessary. Actually, it belongs to the task of every Christian to discern and point out God’s presence. With all of the hurts we face in life, not to mention some fear filled teaching some have received, it is not unusual to run across people with horrible misconceptions of God.

One of the greatest tasks we have as baptized members of His body is to point out His presence in the life of others. There are many who need to grow in their own faith and because they have experienced hardship, have trouble seeing what God is doing with them, if they see Him present at all. The truth is God is always there for us, with us in suffering, and will bring us out of it. Perhaps we can learn from this: when a friend has a problem, our job is not so much to provide an answer but to point to the answer. In other words, our job may not be bringing Christ to others, but revealing His presence already active and intimate with people, especially people who suffer.
