

Church under the Holy Father, has a good amount of autonomy. Each bishop of a diocese has the ability within the confines of Church law to lead his people as he sees fit. Each diocese is meant to mirror the Universal Church in unity as we are all one faith community in union with our bishop, who represent Christ! Remember that our Church is much bigger than our own parish and our whole diocese needs our support.

Dear family,

While sad to admit, we humans are perfectly capable of taking a good thing and ruining it so that we may not even recognize our situation as the same as we started with. Such is the case with our wonderful Church that God has given us: in petty arguments and division we take the beautiful bride of Christ and she

becomes unrecognizably marred in our little wars. We learn in our second reading that this is not a new reality. From the very beginning the Church has suffered when her members decide to make unnecessary divisions hurting the necessary unity and harmony within the Body of Christ. I would be remiss in my role if I did not address the division that currently plagues our Church. From the parish level to the universal level, some have deemed it necessary to express their opinions recklessly on Facebook. From criticizing the Holy Father, to one's bishop, to one's pastor, and even to one's fellow parishioner. This is a huge problem and it lies not in that people disagree with one another, but that we hurt out unity and lack charity while hurting people's faith when this is done. Have we gotten so full of ourselves that we think our opinion needs to be expressed all the time and every time. If it were not for God, we would not even have breath to speak, so we need to mind our tongues and be careful. There is more at stake than we may always realize. Let us learn to live if harmony of one heart and mind, not in conformity but in loving unity and the people of God.


