Dear family,

This past week couples, spouses and lovers celebrated Valentine’s Day in varied ways. In many cases gifts were exchanged, beautiful gifts of chocolates and elegant bouquets were given as

signs of the sentiments and emotions which call to mind the love people have shared. When we examine our experience of love, however, we will often notice that many experiences of showing love and sustaining love are not very pretty. From the not so pleasant changing of diapers to the excruciating helplessness of one holding his partner’s hand as they die of a debilitating and fatal disease, love is not always pretty. It is these moments where love pushes one to deepen his commitment to the other and die to himself. This is not a love that is always popular, in fact, many relationships come to a screeching halt at these moments where the “rubber hits the road.” In our Gospel today, Jesus, in challenging the legal minimalism of the Pharisees, challenges us to make our love deeper extending to those who treat us cruel and those we would define as our enemies. Jesus even states that kindness and love are easy to express to friends and those who treat us well, but it is these difficult cases where we are asked to love (be perfect) as Our Heavenly Father, ‘for he makes his sun rise on the bad and the good, and causes rain to fall on the just and the unjust.’ In His joy,
