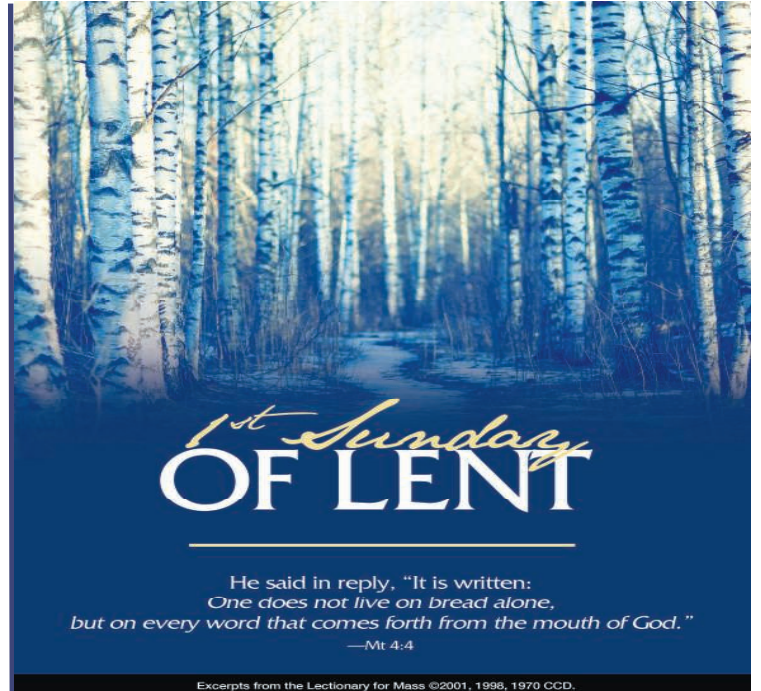

"Did you know?"

Did you know that the other way Our Blessed Lord is present in the Mass is in the readings. The Church has taught and in Vatican II directly reaffirmed that when the readings are done at Mass God quite literally speaks to His people. As a point of comparison, someone quoting Scripture in a conversation or leading a Bible study is not the same as Mass, because while God indeed may be present there in some way, He promises through His Church to be fully present while each reader utters those sacred passages. This is why is not advisable that any other announcements or cantering be done at the ambo (pulpit). Like the altar, it is meant for strictly sacred use only, thus only the three readings and the Gospel should be proclaimed there. Probably the strongest sign of this sacramental presence is in the proclamation of the Gospel. We stand at the sound of the "alleluia" hitting our ears because we believe that Jesus just entered the room and that through the words of the deacon or priest, Jesus (the Word made flesh) speaks to His people just the same way He did 2,000 years ago. At our parish we also honor this sacramental presence by the throne we have created for the Book of the Gospels. To you readers and listeners, let us never forget the great gift we have in Scripture that comes alive at Mass. We get to listen to many words in our lives and some of them quite negative, let's make room to listen attentively to the voice of God that we are privileged to hear. Those who have ears ought to hear!
