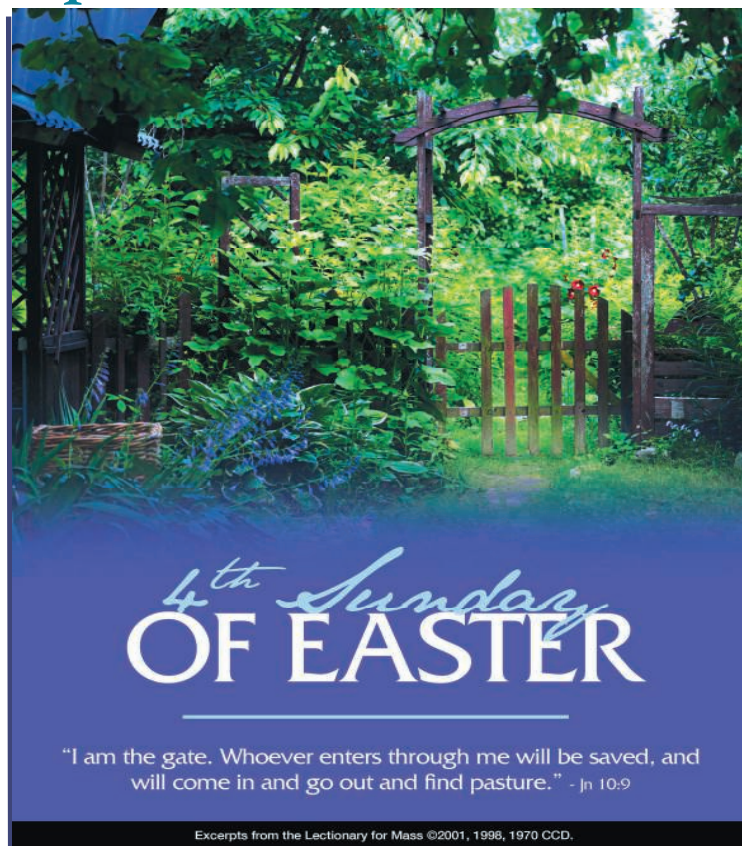

## “Liturgical Tidbits

Have you ever wondered why clergy are also referred to as “men of the cloth?” One explanation is that when a member of the clergy is involved in a liturgy he wears special garb. Our special liturgical garb in the Church are called vestments. Take for example the priest. When presiding at Mass, a priest will wear several vestments. He first wears an alb, which is a white garment that is a reminder of his baptism and the call to holiness associated with it. A clergyman is first and foremost a baptized Christian. Secondly he wears a stole, this is the long and string-like vestment that goes around his neck. The stole represents the priest’s authority given to him by his valid ordination by a bishop. Finally, the priest wears a chasuble for an outer garment. The chasuble can be plain or ornate and is usually of the same color as the liturgical season or feast for which it is worn. The chasuble represents charity or love to symbolize that love is above, and therefore more important than anything else.

Look at the case of Adolf Hitler, who despite carrying out nefarious plans, was able to win over his fellow Germans by his persuasive speaking skills. We can easily be swayed in choosing the wrong people to lead us or chose a leader for the wrong reasons without properly discerning their competence in leading us successfully. There is an authenticity to the leadership of Jesus in His actions, words, and consistent message. Dear people be careful to discern the voices you listen to, we don’t want to place our lives in the wrong hands. Many who claim leadership can promise many things, but only Jesus, who is life, can promise abundant life.
