

Actually, let me be clear, I have decided not to distribute the Blessed Sacrament in the form of the chalice anymore. The Church teaches that whoever receives even the tiniest particle of the Sacred Host, receives Our Lord in His fullness: body, blood, soul, and divinity. As I said in my Corpus Christi homily: God never gives of Himself half-hazardously. Pray that this change brings about in our community a deeper faith in the Blessed Sacrament. If there is anyone who has a wheat allergy, know that you always have the option of going into the sacristy before Mass and filling a chalice for your consumption.

Dear family,

His people. I always think immediately of St. Paul's conversion where Jesus clearly tells Paul, "Why are you persecuting me?" This "attitude" is in keeping with God's nature as seen throughout salvation—history where God is intimately involved in the story of His people. To be so closely and intentionally identified with another is what we would call "compassion," to suffer with another. It is out of this context that God does everything, including forming His Church. In our Gospel today, Jesus says to His apostles, "Whoever received you, received me." These are bold words, because it means that those who are ministers of God in some way bring God's presence with them and that presence, His healing, truth, and love. The fact that God makes such an intimate statement about His ministers puts into our (the Church) a great responsibility. For the laity, this is an act of faith to see Jesus working in His ordained leaders and to encourage them in their vocations. For the clergy, this reality means that we have a duty to live up to a standard, not a standard of our own merit or making, but one of allowing Christ to shine through ourselves, weaknesses and all. As a priest I may never understand why God has given me, a sinner, the gifts He has, except that I see He would like to share His goodness with others.
